

ABSOLUTE FIT "LEASH HARNESS"

COLLAR: Check to make sure that your collar is sturdy and in good condition. Attach the collar to your dog, verifying that NO MORE THAN ONE FINGER can be slipped between the underside of the collar and the dog's coat. Your dog will be able to back out of the collar if not snug.



STEP 1: Attach the leash to the collar and lay the leash along the dog's spine



STEP 2: Hold the leash on the spine right over the shoulders and drape the balance of the leash to the dog's right side.



STEP 3: Pass the leash under the dog's belly just *behind* the front legs.



STEP 4: Put the loop end of the leash under the portion of the leash coming up from the collar and snug it up firmly. NOW the dog can not back out of the collar.
